



On 2d March 1780 Ret'd 8th Feb. 1786
 The above is a Draught of a Tract of land situate on the Waters of Jennie Creek Called Complaint Containing three hundred and Ninety Eight and a half Acres Surveyed May the 10th 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners for the state of Virginia to James Barnett in the following Words

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Land in the Counties of Monongahalea Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Jas Barnett is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Monongahalea on the Waters of Jennie Creek to include his actual Settlement made in the Year 1773 also a Right in pre-emption to one thousand Acres adjoining there to Given under our hands at Coxes fort the Eighteenth day of February 1780. in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
