The above is a Draught of a Tract of land situate on the Waters of Little Creek Called Complaint Containing Three hundred and Ninety Eight Land a half Acres Surveyed on the 10th 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners for the State of Virginia to Juries Barreling the following Words

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpa-
tented Land in the Counties of Montgomery Washington
& Otio do hereby Certify that Jas Barnett is Entitled to four
hundred Acres of Land in the County of Montgomery
on the Waters of Dennile Creek to include his Actual
Settlement made in the Year 1773 Also a Right in pre-
emption to one Thousand Acres Adjoining There to
Given under our hands at Coxes for the Eighteenth day of
February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
of Pa.
