



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Sugar Tree Grove situate on the Head of the Waters of Conemough Creek and on the Waters of the Chest Creek on the west Branch thereof of about two Miles above the upper Forks of the Chest Creek: near two Miles west from the west end of the Proprietaries Manor of _____ about eight or nine Miles above where the Path from Frankstown to Kittanning crosses the Chest Creek adjoining Lands of Hugh Howell and John Nagle in the County of Bedford: containing three Hundred and sixty one Acres & thirty nine Perches and the usual Allowance of Six Percent. for Roads &c surveyed the 22d Day of June 1773 for Stacey Hepburn in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 13th Day of May in the same year To John Bukens Esq & Thomas Smith D.S. Surveyor General ~
