


Jacob Beachie's other tract



Situate on the Waters of Stoney Creek including Hills Improvement so called in Stoney Creek Township Somerset County, (late Bedford) and was Surveyed the 10th day of October 1793 for John Rhodes in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 23rd day of January 1793: a dispute ensued, Stoller obtained Hills Improvement right, disputed Rhodes's claim by purchasing his Warrant, and the land is now returned Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Casper Stoller dated the 6th day of January 1794 for 500 Acres at \$10. per hundred, during the winter of the 1st March 1775. which is believed to be the date of Hills first Improvement.
