



The above survey containing 48 3/4 acres is part of a tract of land Surveyed the 10th Day of November 1785 in pursuance of a warrant to Jonathan Duncan dated the 21st day of September 1785 the land was then in Franklin Township Fayette County but now in Dimbar Township. The piece now surveyed has been obliterated
