



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Proximity bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland being numbered in the general Plan of said Town Fifty one and granted to Ellis Hughes Esq. containing in Length East and West Two Hundred and thirty feet and in Breadth North and South Fifty seven feet Six Inches Bounded Westward by Broad Way Southward by Lot n^o Fifty two Eastward by River Alley and Northward by Lot number Fifty as by the general Plan remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear. Returned in to the Secretary's Office the 15th January 1773 by Warrant dated 14th of the same Month.
