



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Trimanagh Township (formerly Cumberland) now Mcifflin County, appears Survey'd the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1769 (By W<sup>m</sup> Maday late Deputy Surveyor) and said to Contain 246.2 Acres &c &c In pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to Adam Porter dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August. 1766 No. 998 for 250. acres

Resurvey'd the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 1798 agreeable to the old lines and corners and appears to Contain Two hundred and Fifty eight acres and 15 perches and the allowance of Six p<sup>er</sup> Cent for roads &c
