



The above is a draught of a Survey made 5th day of Feb^r 1785 In pursuance of a warrant Granted to Ceaser Hendrick dated the 25th Day of Oct^r 1784. Situate on a Branch of Fish Creek in Washington County. Called Thistle Containing four hundred acres with one allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads.
