



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Exeter in the County of Berks.  
Containing one hundred and two acres, sixty-eight perches, and the allowance of six  
per cent. for roads &c. surveyed for John Troxel, Mary Ebling, Lewis Jackson, John  
M. F. Bishop, Gorrilla Moyer, Jacob G. Hertzog, and John Esterly, the eighteenth day  
of November 1873. being part of a larger tract of one hundred and twelve acres and one  
hundred and four perches, and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a war-  
rant granted to Andrew & Barbara Dorst dated the fifth day of June 1765.
