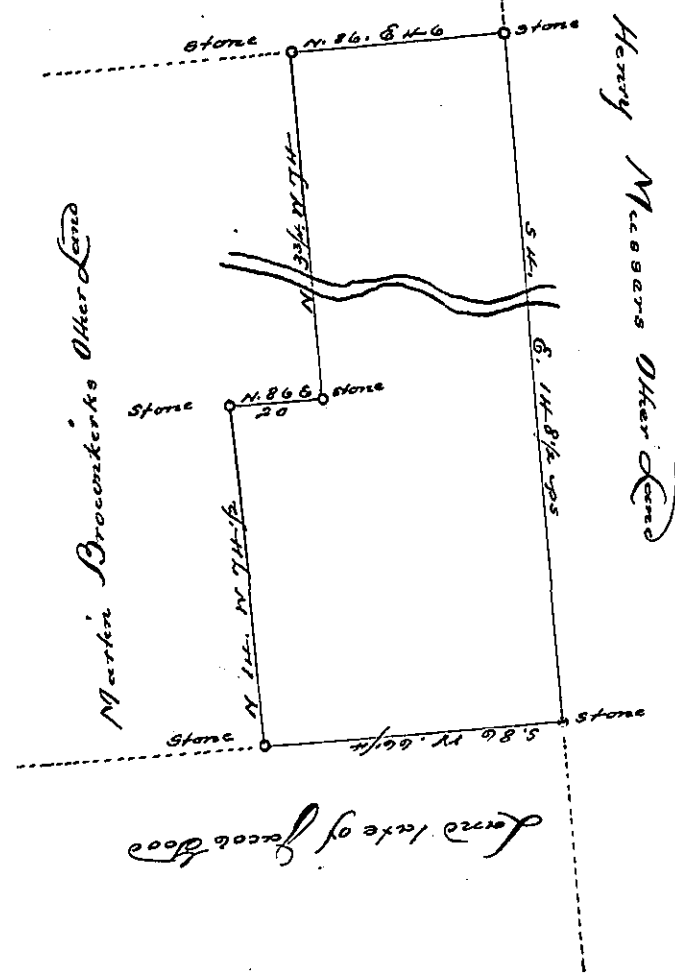


Land late of Philip Stover
