Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was originally surveyed by William Kersey dated on the 4<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Mo<sup>o</sup> - 1790. In pursuance of a Warrant for 30<sup>th</sup> granted to Francis Grove bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 1789. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May Anno Domini 1809 for John Krook the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught
