

East side of the North East branch of Susquehanna opposite and below the Falls  
opposite other land surveyed for Francis West in Northumberland County, con-  
taining fifty four acres & seventy four perches besides the usual allowance of  
6 yds Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 1st June 1791, for the said Francis West.  
In pursuance of an order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 Number before.
