



Situated in Manallen Township York County and Resurveyed nearly by the old lines the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1758. In pursuance of two warrants (or extracts from two Warrants by Geo. Stephenson) one for one hundred acres of Land adjoining George Wilson & John Marton in Manallen Township York County dated 1<sup>st</sup> April 1752. The other for 200<sup>+</sup> adjoining their other land the Rampet hill and Bear Mountain <sup>both</sup> granted to Robert Miller and John Campbell. Dated 18<sup>th</sup> October 1753.

N.B. This Tract of Land was surveyed by Francis McCulloch one of Geo. Stephensons Deputies for Robert Miller and John Campbell but not Returned
