



Situated in Manasseh Township York County and Resurveyed nearly by the old
lines the 3^d day of April 1788. In consequence of two warrants (or extracts from
two Warrants by Geo. Stephenson) one for one hundred acres of Land adjoining
George Wilson & John Morton in Manasseh Township York County dated
1st April 1752. The other for 20 a.^w adjoining their other land the Rompeka kill
and Bear Mountain ^{both} granted to Robert Miller and John Campbell Dated 18th
October 1753.

N.B. This Tract of Land was surveyed by Francis McCulloch, one
of Geo. Steypherson's Deputies for Robert Miller and John Campbell
but not Returned
