Dated May 1767. & N<sup>o</sup> 4789 Dated March 2<sup>d</sup> 1768. but laid off therefrom In pursuance of the Directions of the Last will and Testament of the said Tobias Styer, deceased, And Returned into the Surveyor General's Office In pursuance of a warrant of Re-survey and Division. Granted unto the said Jacob Graff and Jacob Eversoit bearing Date the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774
