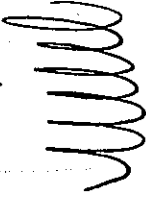

Surveyed by Thomas Armer on the 11th day of January A.D. 1757 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Elijah Eastwood, dated the 17th day of October A.D. 1753, as appears by a Draught of the same remaining in the Deputy Surveyors Office of said County - presuming therefore that said survey was made by direction of George Stevenson late D.S. the same is at the request of _____ Miller (the present owner of part of said tract) examined, corrected, calculated, and returned for confirmation as the official work of the said George Stevenson
