



Situated on the Headwaters of White Deer hole Creek in Washington Township Lycoming County. Surveyed on the 27th & 28th of June 1828. Containing four hundred acres, and allowed of six per Cent. Dr. for Daniel High in pursuance of his warrant, bearing date the 28 day of April 1821. taken from the field work of N. W. McHenry then Deputy Surveyor.
