



The above described piece of land was originally a part of Asaiah Jennings's land but was surveyed off at the request of George Yeagle who became vested with a right to said piece of land, the survey was made on the 21st day of May 1800 and it contains as above eight acres and ¹¹³/₁₀₀ perches of land ~~strict measure~~ ^{and allowance} and is situated in Mahanoy Town^{ship}. The Warrant ~~to Asaiah Jennings~~ ^{of application} was dated 5th of April 1765 No 157 for 250 acs on which there was surveyed & Returned 245 acs 79 perches & all. Certified this 17th of April 1804 By W^m Montgomery D^{ist}.
