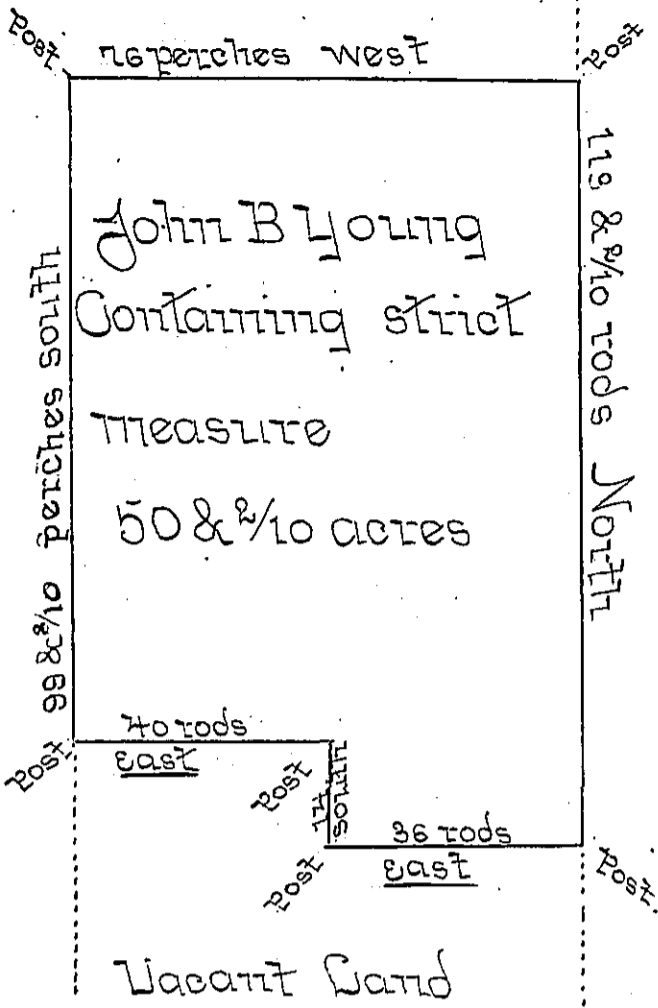

NEW WARRANT

By virtue of a warrant issued the tenth day of Feb. 1845 surveyed Feb. 27th 1845 unto John B Young Containing fifty & two tenths acres strict measure or forty seven and one hundred twentieth of an acre with the usual allowance of six per cent situate on the East side of Potatoes Creek about one mile from its mouth in M^cKeen County adjoining lands surveyed to John Keating and Company and vacant land said forty seven acres has been occupied for last four years by William Rice who claims it by settlers right Feb. 28th 1845
