



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Upper Milford Town-
 ship in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania
 Containing Forty Acres and 126 Perches of Land Together with
 The usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads. That was Sur-
 veyed on the 14th February Anno. 1766. to David Shultze. By
 Virtue of an Order from The Surveyor General, Dated at Phil-
 adelphia on the first Day of October. Anno. 1765. & granted
 to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries of this Province in Pur-
 suance of an Application made by him for Forty acres
 of Land, situate in the Township and Place aforesaid &c.
 He the said David Shultze hath now sold and Conveyed all his
 Right Claim and Demand what soever to the same Tract of Land
 to Henry Funk: formerly Surveyed By Order of James Scull Dep-
 uty Surveyor for the said County &c. and now Drawn for the
 said Henry Funk: on the 25th March. Anno. 1750.
