


The Warrant in the name of Moore & Gough
is Dated July 1784 James H. Gough



In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Survey dated -
October 3rd 1810 Resurveyed and divided the above described
Tract of Land from an Original Survey of Moore & Gough
situate on the waters of Middle Creek in Canaan Township
Wayne County, containing in the part sold by Robt
L. Hooper to Benjamin Haines Ninety-four Acres, one
hundred forty-two perches & allowance in the part sold
by the same to John Ross, the same quantity, and in
the residue of the Tract, Two hundred and ten Acres,
one hundred & sixteen perches & allowance of six P.
Cent. The whole Tract containing Four hundred Acres
and eighty perches & allowance of Six P. Cent. The lines
marked (a) were formerly run & marked as
John W. Porter Esq Surveyor Genl E. Kellogg U.S.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the
Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made con-
formably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this
