



Situate on the waters of the Raystown Branch of the Juniata River in Hopewell now Tod Township Huntingdon County Surveyed the 30th day of April AD 1794 by John Canan the then D.S. of said County on a Warrant to Benjamin Rush dated the 31st day of March 1794. Resurveyed and corrected the 1st & 2nd day of November 1852 in pursuance of an order of Resurvey granted to George Runble & William Miller Trustees & Devises of the estate of John Savage dead dated the 6th day of October 1838.
