

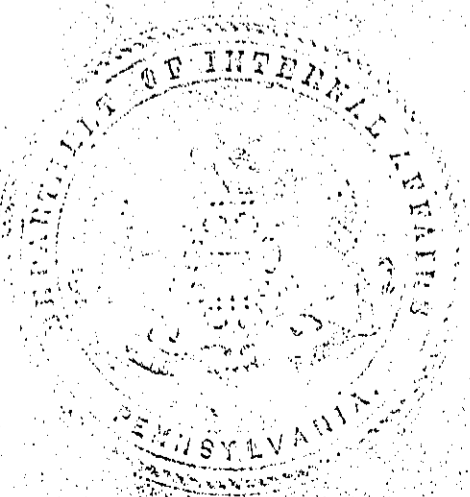
Draft of Seventy eight Cores and eighteen perches of the
