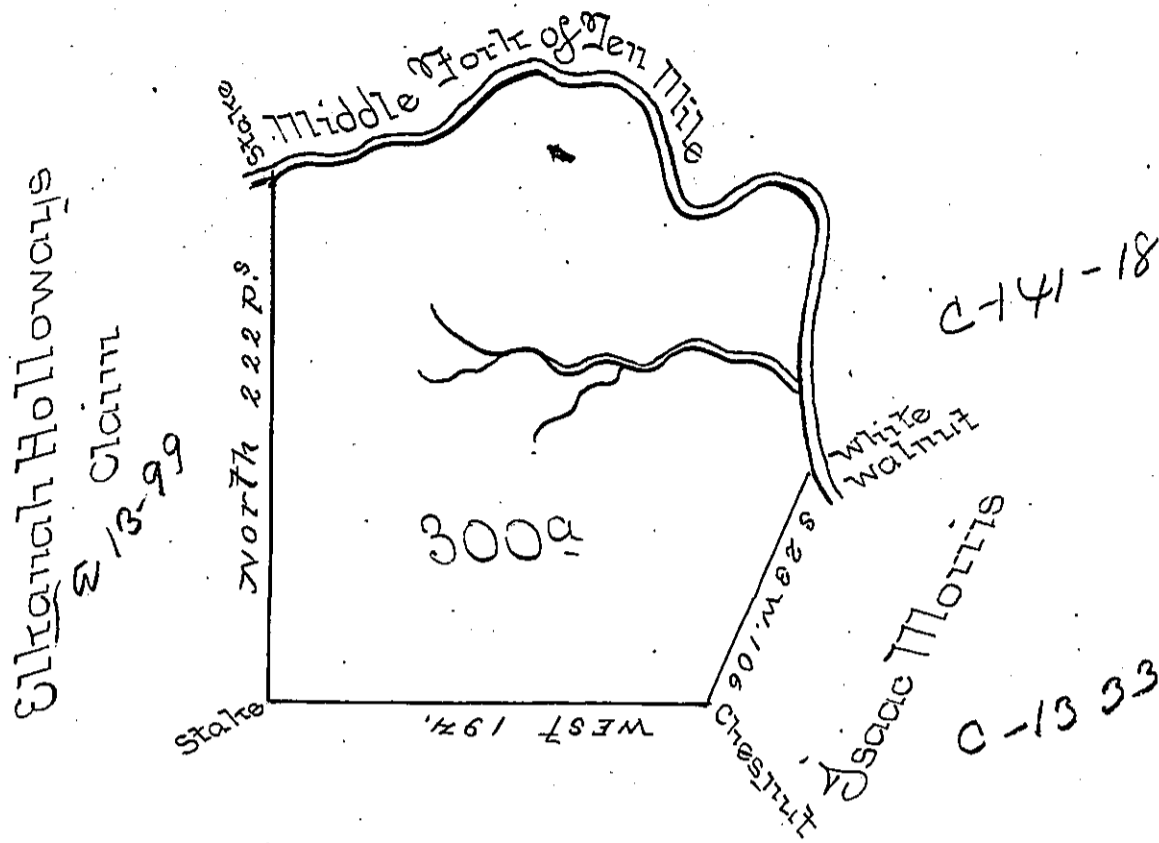

(Amwell top)

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May 13th 1787 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to David Enoch Jun^r dated June 29th 1785. The Land is situated on the Middle Fork of Ten Mile Creek in Washington County &c - called Batchelors Hall containing Three hundred Acres with allowance of 6 per Cent.
