



A Draught of a Tract of Land called The Elk Pasture (being part of a larger Tract of that name) situated on Otter Creek or little Conemaoh including part of both branches about half a Mile above the Forks & about half a Mile below the great Elk Hook on the North Branch adjoining Land of John Perry and John Smallwood in Frankstown Township in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and fifteen Acres and the usual Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of September 1773 for Joseph Meyer by virtue of a Warrant Dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of July in the same year by
