The one marked letter A is part of a tract originally Surveyed March the 8th A.D. 1828 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry C. Peck & Isaac Coalty. Dated February 25th A.D. 1828. The one marked letter B. was surveyed for Ephratah Coalty the 27th of October 1841 in pursuance of a warrant granted to the said Ephratah Coalty for 40 acres dated March 26th 1841. The one marked letter C. is part of a tract was Surveyed on a warrant in the name of Daniel Major for 403 acres.
