



Situate in Mahoning Township in Northumberland County adjoining lands of Peter Blue John Alexander & others containing One hundred & fifty three acres & one hundred & forty four perches & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Surveyed unto Daniel Montgomery on the 10 Day of October 1810 by virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1807 -
