

The above is a draught of a Tract of Land called Greenock Hill situate on Campbell's Run in Washington County, containing Three hundred & fifty five Acres with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads, Highways &c. Surveyed for James Wrigley Augt 1st 1785.
