



Situate in York Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth $142 \frac{3}{4}$ ^{acres} and allowance. Being the same Land which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. for John Shoemaker, in pursuance of an Order from Richard Stockley Esquire to agree for 200^{acres} directing to be Surveyed in or near the Manor of Springetsbury granted to the said John Shoemaker bearing date the 15th day of June 1772. And now at the request of Adam Bahn, Michael Welsh and others present owners, I am desired to make return of the Draught as Calculated examined and found to be correct the 9th day of February 1820.

To B. The Land above described is situated southward of the southern line of Springetsbury Manor about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile and lies entirely outside of the Proprietaries reserved Land.
