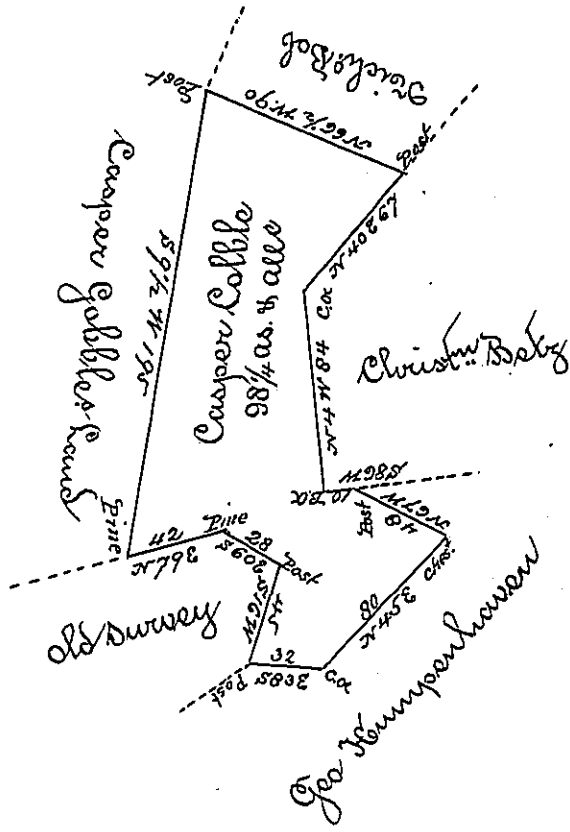


This Warrant is dated 5th April 1786
