



Situate in Mannheim Township in the County of York: That part where the letter A is placed containing as above set forth 9^{ac} & 161^{perches} allowance being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed by Archibald Mc Cleau late D.S. to Charles Young in right of Henry Forum on the 25th day of September 1766 in pursuance of a Warrant dated May 31st 1762. That part where the letter B. is placed containing 4^{ac} & 110^{perches} and allowance being part of a larger tract which was also surveyed by the said Archibald Mc Cleau late D.S. on the same day to Charles Young in pursuance of a Warrant dated April 30th 1765. Surveyed and divided off from the said larger tracts of land the 12th day of September Anno Domini 1802. for and at the request of Nathias Trace Sen^r the present owner who desired us to make Return of the Draught in order to obtain a Patent for the same.
