



December 16<sup>th</sup> 1811 Survey'd for Robert Deegester and John McDowell in right of John Quinn, the above <sup>described</sup> part of a tract of Land Containing one hundred and forty three acres and one hundred and ten perches and sixteenths of a perch and allowance proportioned at six per cent, it being part of a larger tract which was surveyed to the aforesaid John Quinn said to contain two hundred and fifteen acres and one hundred and fifty perches & allowance on his Work dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 1815 situate on the waters of Beaver Run in Washington Township in the County of Westmoreland.
