

A Draught of a tract of land situate about three fowards of a mile E.W. of the black swamp on the head water of big Jobys Creek in the last purchase District 90° 4 Surveyed the twelfth day of July 1793 in pursuance of a warrant 90° 2345 to Willem Willink & Nicholas Van Skayhorst Christian Van Eggen Hendrik Vollenhoven and Reiniger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 A.R. Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety A.R. & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c
