



Thomas Jordan in right of Samuel Watson 40 Acres and allowance as above described situate in Hopewell Township York County Surveyed the 15th of 12 mo. 1791. In pursuance of the Application No: 3899 Dated the 18th day of June 1762 - by virtue whereof a survey of 78^{acres} was made and returned in the year 1768. Which interferes with Rowland Rogers' survey then belonging to Orphan, and no person appearing to shew the lines but the above is clear.
