



The blue lines of the above diagram embraces a tract of land called Houlberry Mill, situate on Charliers Creek in Strabane Township Washington County, which said tract appears to have been surveyed for Michael Marshall the 4th day of November A.D. 1769, in pursuance of an Order No. 3625 dated the 8th day of July 1769. That part of said tract described by black lines and courses and distances was resurveyed the 31st day of March 1824 for William Quail the present owner and occupier, and contains nine acres and ninety two perches and allowance of six Dr. Ct. [Compartment No. 1. Marked A, was also resurveyed for William Quail the 2nd day of November 1822 and a return thereof forwarded to the Surveyor General's Office in November 1823. The residue of said tract, marked B. & C. is now owned by James Orr Esq. and Daniel Moore of the Borough of Washington, Washington County Pa.
