



By Virtue of a Warrl from the Honrble Proprietaries ear-
ily Date the Twenty-fifth Day of March (Dom) 1738 I have Surveyed
& Laid out unto John Young in the Township of Pennsborough into
the County of Lancaster on the West-side of Susquehanna River Two
Hundred and Thirteen acres of Land with allowance of six Rods
Beginning at an Elm tree standing by Coneledaqua or Conew Creek Then
west one hundred and forty five perches to a White Oak a corner of
Robert Gilkisons Land thence by the same Land South ninty five
perches to a white Oak thence East West forty four perches to a
Walnutt thence South fifteen Degrees West by Seventy seven perches
to a Red Oak a corner of James Youngs Land thence East one hun-
dred ninty nine perches and three Rods to another corner
thence North Seventy two perches to a White Oak thence North East
Twenty five perches to a Hickory by the sd Creek Then up the same
traversing the Severall corners thereof near about Eighty Rods to
the place of Beginning
