



Situate on Youngs Mill Run, a branch of Gists Run in Durbar, formerly a part of Franklin Township, Fayette County and Surveyed under the direction of Alfred M'Clean late 2d for the — day of — 1795 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of said Young for 300 acres of Land dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1793. I find the foregoing to be correct and properly located, as there must have been an error in the Warrant in calling it Sharptown Township  
 There was an old mill some years ago and a small improvement <sup>on this tract</sup> but the mill has been suffered to go to decay.
