



Tract in Washington (late Warrington) Township York County, containing within the black lines as above set forth one hundred and sixty three acres, fifty perches and allowance of five per cent for roads &c. being part of a larger tract of 172^{acres} and allowance originally surveyed by Charles Lukens Esq. late Deft on the 8th day of November 1769 to George Moeserough and pursuant of a warrant granted to Robert Conner for — acres dated the 13th day of August 1752. The above part resurveyed and divided off the said larger tract for David Kimmel the present owner of said part at whose request the same is returned for confirmation
