



Situate in Dover Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 1741/8^{as} and allowance of 8/2^{as} originally surveyed by George Shivers on late D.S. on the 1st day of June 1756 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Garber (alias) Carver bearing date the 14th day of March 1755. —

Resurveyed by the old lines on the 9th day of June 1812, at the request of the owners Francis Gammoth & Henry Hering, who desired that the same should be returned for Confirmation.
