Originally surveyed by Jacob Spangler D.S. in Pursuance of a Warrant for 15^{as} dated the 4th day of December 1798 granted to John Erman, & the part represented by the letter C. contains 7^{as} 74^{ps} and allowances. Originally surveyed by Jacob Spangler D.S. in Pursuance of a Warrant for 4^{as} dated the 4th December 1798 granted to David Sheffer, & the part represented by D contains 5^{as} 70^{ps} & allowances & is part of a larger tract. & the above resurveyed on the 4th day of August 1830. by John Becker D.S. at the request of Simon Koller now on the 5th day of December A.D. 1839. Being requested to make return of the parts not returned. by William Heacock the present owner for Patenting & note 19^{as} 10^{ps} & ca is part of 97^{as} 139^{ps} & ca. Originally surveyed on two Warrants from 4^{as} 40^{ps} dated 9th October 1750 the other for 50^{as} dated 4th April 1751 both granted to Philip Low Called Trout Run
