



The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land called Butterwood Bottom, Situate on the waters of Clearfield Creek; adjoining lands surveyed for Alexander Barclay; Separated by a pine Swamp from Alex: Stewart's Survey; at the Chest in Cumberland County; containing Three Hundred and Seventeen acres and Three Quarters, and the usual allowance of Six yo Cent for Roads, &c. Surveyed the 30th day of June 1769. for Josiath Rees, In pursuance of an order. No 3001. Dated the 8th day of April.
