



The above is the draught of a survey made May 12th. 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Thomas on the 25th. day of April 1793. Situate Northwest of the Ohio River on the waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to Wm. N. Wells. George Eddy & Jermia Parker, called Frilburg, containing 400 acres with the usual allowance of 670 Cent &c.
