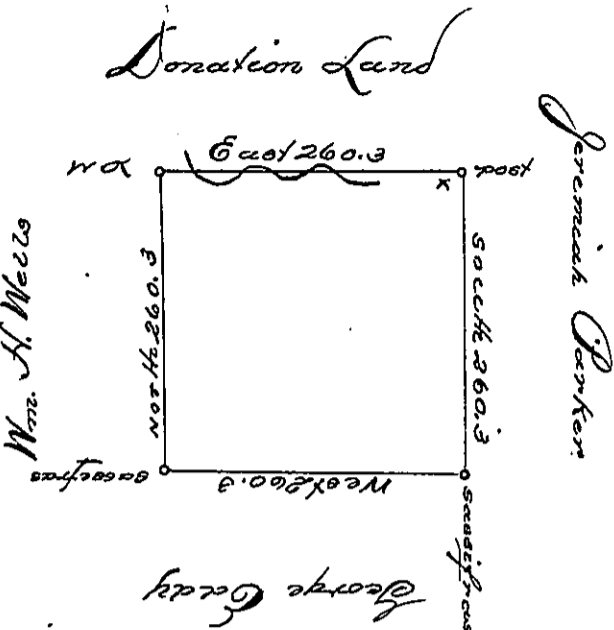


See Warrant To
John Harrison et al

The above described Tract of Land situate in my district. Beaver County ad-
joining Land granted to Mrs. H. Wells, Geo. Cady & Jeremiah Parker, called Fry-
berg. Containing four hundred acres with the usual allowance was surveyed
by Geo Redick & myself under the directions of Geo Noge Esqr. Late Deputy
Surveyor, in the month of March 1795, in pursuance of a warrant granted
to Joseph Thomas dated on the twenty fifth day of April 1793. which
survey was returned into the Surveyor Gen^ls Office by said Noge as if sur-
veyed in May 1794, the last mentioned date of survey being erroneous.

I do now certify and return this survey
into the Surveyor Gen^ls Off. for the purpose of correcting said error,
in compliance with the order of the Board of Property dated the 8th June 1803
