



By virtue of a warrant dated the 23^d March 1801 Surveyed the 11^d October 1801 to Adam Hawk the above
described tract of land situate in Plainfield Township Northampton County containing two hundred
and seventy six acres fifty perches and the allowance of six poles A.D.

The above land has been improved 30 or 40 years ago — Since surveying the above I have been informed by Marks John Bridle Esquire that it was surveyed in consequence of the following warrant given to Walter Miller 100 acres more or less at the great swamp near the head of the Buckkill about three miles from

Francis Corvis near the Blue Mountain. Warrant dated 26th June 1750.

24th October 1750. Walter Miller by acknowledgement on the back of the warrant received the said warrant to William Craig.

10th February, 1782. William Craig conveyed a moiety thereof to Edward Duer in Craig and the other moiety to Mrs. Ricky
who died intestate, Gideon Ricky administrator.

7th March 1770. Edward Dennis bears conveyed their moiety to James Biddle.

20th June, 1775. James Beadle conveyed to Elizab. Richy.

The Land was sold by the Sheriff for a debt due to James Beadle and was purchased at said sale by Mr. Craig who conveyed it to John Nicholson Esquire
