



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Mill Seat, situate on the South side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniata River including the Mouth of a Large Spring Run now called Spring Creek or Pony Creek partly opposite the lower end of the Conoco Narrows and Land applied for by Robert Andrews adjoining a Survey of William Cox Esquire in the name of George Burns and Land granted to Valentine Leaser in the Township of County of Bedford containing three hundred and twenty nine acres and the usual Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 30th day of May 1772 for Alexander Douglass in pursuance of an Order No 4135. Dated the 3^d day of July 1767. by
