



Situated on a branch of the Shawanese Cabin Creek in St. Clair Township (formerly Cumberland) now Bedford County, containing one hundred & 61 Acres $\frac{3}{4}$ & allowance of six fm. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for John Pollock the 22nd Day of January 1800 along old lines on location dated September 15th 1766.
