In pursuance of a warrant granted to George Rife for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 10th day of January A.D. 1785. The whole Survey said to contain 424 1/2 acres & 22<sup>ac</sup>, the residue of which was returned for patenting to Jacob Lehmer Jr. by John McClean Esq. D.S. on the 29th day of Jan'y. 1812. as appears by his official Draught thereof remaining in my office, Certified this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1831.
