

The above is a Draught of a Survey made July 20th 1785, for Matthew Rankin
in pursuance of a Certificate granted him in the following words: We the Commissioners
for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela & Yohogana
and Ohio do hereby Certify that Matthew Rankin is entitled to four hundred acres of
land in the County of Yohogana to include his Settlement made in the year one thousand seven-
hundred and seventy, Also a right pre-emption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto.
Given under our hands at Cox's fort the seventeenth day of February 1780 in
the fourth year of the Commonwealth in Francis Peyton
