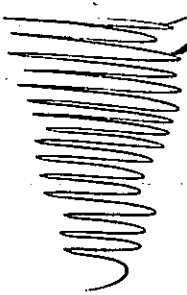


Land Seized by one Cheney

The Draught of a Tract of Land called *Stiffredrews*, situate in the Long Hollow in the county of Cumberland containing one hundred ninety one acres and sixty eight perches with the usual allowance of six acres per Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 10th July A.D. 1766. In pursuance of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries to Andrew Wilkins Bearing Date at Philadelphia the 4th Day of June. Anno Dom. 1762.
