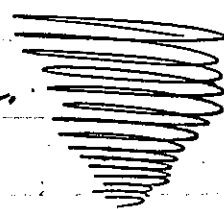


A Draught of an Island in the River Susquehanna Manor Township Lancaster County called Taylors Island opposite York shore about three quarters of a mile fifteen perches from said shore, and about sixty perches from the Maple Island, & about eighteen or twenty perches from the Island called Woods Island, lying on the course of the York shore opposite to Wislers Island, which said Island containing six perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 7th day of November Anno Domini 1821, granted to George Albright & Martin Fink.
